



Audio-visual information for weddings:

Vocal PA/Speakers: We have two portable speakers that come with stands. This PA is strictly used for speeches only, amplified music must not be played through these speakers. Guests are required to organise their own PA for music/the band/DJ/iPod dock. We do not have a mini-jack to RCA on site; anything you require to play music must be supplied.

Lighting: KVBR is a 'clean venue'. We have standard lights on dimmer switches throughout the hall and pergola area but groups who require specialised lighting e.g. coloured par cans, fairy lights, lasers, disco balls etc need to supply their own. There are ample sockets for additional plugs and the managers are happy to assist with any rigging (we have 3 x ladders).

Microphones: We can supply you with 1 x microphone (with xlr leads) & 1 x microphone stand for speeches.

Projector: We have a projector (Epsom WXCA A=16:9 R=800x600) in the hall which sits in a cradle attached to the roof (so is not movable). This projects onto the white wall above the fireplace and can be used for presentations/skype. Computers plug into a long HDMI lead to the right of the fireplace. If using a Mac, you will need to bring your own Apple-Thunderbolt.

Wi-Fi: Kangaroo Valley is restricted to very small data levels. Guests who require an internet connection tether off their own phones (Optus & Telstra are best).

TV & DVD player: There is a TV and DVD player in the lodge that picks up a small number of local channels and can play DVD's, often this is used by parents or babysitters for occupying children after the wedding reception.

Power to Sunset Deck & Rock Cathedral: All of the high use areas on the property have access to at least one standard 3-pin Australasian plug. This includes the sunset deck, Rock Cathedral, al fresco dining area, pool & campsites. Please bring your own powerboards/leads.

Noise policy: Council policy restricts us to certain noise levels and times when amplified music must be turned off. This is our one major licence requirement on the property and is strictly enforced. We have a decibel meter in the hall and if the noise level reaches above 100 db, we will request that this is reduced. Please pass this information on to your band/DJ to avoid major interruptions and possible equipment failure during your celebrations. After 8pm, all amplified music must cease anywhere on the property apart from the hall. You are welcome to have acoustic guitars playing anytime.

The noise policy is as follows:

- Friday & Saturday nights, amplified music must be turned off in the hall at midnight.
- Sunday through Thursday nights, amplified music must be turned off in the hall at 10pm.
- All week, amplified music must cease in cabins and outside areas at 8pm
